Althea V. McClyment of Easton, formerly of Ridgely, MD died at the Talbot Hospice House, Easton, MD on Thursday, April 5, 2007. She was 84. Born on January 7, 1923 in Ridgely, MD, she was the daughter of the late, James Clark and Mary Leona Marvel Woodward. She was a 1940 graduate of Ridgely High School and on November 25, 1940 she married Donald Lee McClyment of Centreville, MD.

In 1948, she and her husband moved to Baltimore where she was employed at Montgomery Wards as cashier for four years. She then began working at Monarch Finer Foods as assistant buyer for seven years. In 1963, she began a 24 year career with Westinghouse Electric as junior accountant, retiring in 1987. She and her family moved to Grasonville, MD where she retired and resided for 19 years. She later moved to Ridgely, MD and in 2001 to Hyde Park in Easton.

Mrs. McClyment is a member of the New Life Christian Outreach in Chester, where she served on the Board from 1978 to 1986, the G.C. Coker Lay Witness Mission Team out of Sandston, VA, and the Grasonville Women's Aglow serving as treasurer and recording secretary. She is a past member of Prison Ministry with the Fluhartys of Denton, MD and was involved in several Bible studies and often had prayer groups at her place of work and own home. Upon moving to Hyde Park, in 2001, she became involved in Faith and

Compassion Fellowship and Bible School.

Mrs. McClyment is survived by one son, Donald L. McClyment, Jr. and his wife, Vivian of Queenstown, MD; a granddaughter, Melanie D. McClyment, of Easton, MD and two siblings, Doris E. Wooten, of Greenwood, DE and C. Marvel Woodward of Ridgely, MD. Her husband of 32 years and her brother, James K. Woodward, predecease her.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, April 10, 2007 at 11:00 AM at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Centreville, MD where friends and family may call on Monday evening from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM .

Burial will be in Chesterfield Cemetery, Centreville, MD.
