



Alvin Butler Lane, Sr.

December 1, 1922 - February 3, 2013

Alvin Butler Lane, Sr., of Centreville, MD, died at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD, on Sunday, February 3, 2013. He was 90.

Born December 1, 1922, in Preston, MD, he was the son of the late James Roy and Maude Marie Butler Lane. He was raised in the Trappe area and attended Trappe High School. He worked for different farms as a sharecropper until he joined the U.S. Navy where he served overseas during World War II aboard the destroyer U.S.S. Gainard DD 706 when the atomic bombs were dropped on Japan. Following his release from active duty, he returned to farming and later began his career as a salesman for FritoLay and other firms.

He enjoyed quail and rabbit hunting, woodworking, and building picnic tables and bird houses.

He was a member of the Easton Church of God for over 60 years where he served in many capacities and taught Sunday School for many years.

Mr. Lane is survived by his wife, Mildred Dashiell Lane; two sons, Alvin B. Lane, Jr., and his wife, Karen Glenn of Centreville, MD, and Patrick W. Lane and his wife, Linda of Hurlock, MD; two daughters, Nancy L. Chard and her husband, Robert of Florence, AL; and Gloria L. Quidas and her husband,

Edward of Preston, MD; three sisters, Marie Chance of Easton, MD, Betty Williamson of Federalsburg, MD, and Ruth Rice of Seaford, DE; 11 grandchildren; 29 great-grandchildren; and four great-great grandchildren. He was pre-deceased by his first wife of 66 years, Hannah Lane; a sister, Frances Butler; and six brothers, Ralph, Donald, Roger, Lee, Harold, and David Lane.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, February 11, 2013, at 11 a.m. at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home in Centreville where friends and family may call from 10 – 11 a.m.
