September 26, 1936 - April 16, 2012

C. Alvin Sanger died Monday, April 16, 2012, at the University of Maryland Medical Center, surrounded by his family. He was 75.

Born September 26, 1936 in Easton, MD, he was the son of the late C. Edgar Schwaninger and Leila Cherbonnier.

Mr. Sanger was a lifelong resident of Cordova, MD, and, during the majority of his life, worked for the U.S. Postal Service where he retired in September, 1992, with the position of Postmaster.

He was a member of the Easton Church of the Brethren.

He is survived by his wife, the former Betty Ann Simmons, whom he married on October 11, 1958, in Easton; three children, Joy Marshall (Phil), Wendy Faulkner (Gary) and Laurie Schnaitman (Billy); a brother, Dennis Sanger; six grandchildren, Doug Rathell (Brooke), Kelley Rathell, Matthew Faulkner, Dylan Faulkner, Justy Schnaitman and Bill Schnaitman; and two great-grandchildren, Huxlee Rathell and Sanger Rathell.

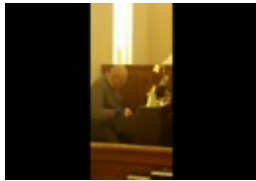
