Amos Ray Ewing of Grasonville died at VA Maryland Healthcare System, Perry Point, on August 19, 2001. He was 74.

Born on February 15, 1927 on Kent Island, he was the son of the late Anna Catherine Cray and Raymond Ewing. After graduating from Stevensville High School class of 1943, he served in the Army overseas during WWII. After being honorably discharged, he returned to Kent Island and married Mary L. Gardner on February 1, 1947. Mr. Ewing worked as a farmer and waterman until retiring. He was a member of the VFW Post #7464, Grasonville, and the Jeff Davis Post American Legion in Centreville.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a daughter, Mary R. Ewing of Ridgely; a brother, James Ewing of Chester; four grandchildren, Chet Clough of Centreville, Billy Clough of Queen Anne, Micah Clough of Grasonville and Katie Clough of Glen Burnie; and three great-grandchildren, Cody, Jessica and Jennifer Clough.
