Andrea Lynn Jedrowicz died Tuesday, July 28, 2009 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. She was 45.

Born on April 16, 1964 to Bernard and Mary Ecker Jedrowicz in Baltimore, living in Locust Point, MD, Andrea grew up in Cape St Clair before moving to Chester. She was a graduate of Queen Anne's County High School, class of 1982. Andrea worked for Goulds as a stenographer before attending Anne Arundel Community College to receive her Associates Degree in Fine Arts. She worked for private defense contractors in the Washington, D.C. area before becoming ill.

She enjoyed modeling, drawing, painting, and being a make-up artist. She was a member of St Christopher's Catholic Church.

Andrea is survived by her parents, Bernard and Mary Jedrowicz of Chester, MD and many aunts, uncles, and cousins.
