



## Andrew McAllister

Andrew Patrick McAllister of Chestertown, Maryland died on Friday, January 3, 2003 at his home. He was 67.

Born in Elkton, Maryland he was the son of the late Andrew Holt & Elsie R. Cameron McAllister.

In 1953 he graduated from Elkton High School, Elkton, MD. He enlisted in the Naval Reserve and then enlisted into the Army and was honorably discharged in 1961 as a SPC 4. After he served in the Army he started his own auto mechanic business, McAllister's Automotive Enterprises in Elkton, MD. In May of 1975 he moved to Chestertown, MD and Married Mary F. Warrington on October 1, 1976. He then worked for himself as a watermen. He worked as a Marine Mechanic at various marinas in Kent and Cecil Counties. He received his Captain license from the United States Coast Guard in 1984.

Mr. McAllister was a member of the Greater Elkton Jaycees as well as the past president of the Cecil County Jaycees and past Regional director of the Democratic Club of Maryland. He was also past president of the Elkton Kiwanis Club and past board member of the Cecil County Board of Elections. Mr. McAllister also served as 4th VP of the Automotive Service Council of Maryland (ASCOM) and was a member of the Chestertown Elks Lodge # 2474 and the Frank Jarmin American Legion Post # 36 of Chestertown, MD.

Mr. McAllister's hobbies include boating, hunting, fishing and golf, he was also an avid Ravens Football Fan.

In addition to his wife Mr. McAllister is survived by 4 sons; TFC Patrick McAllister, Brian McAllister both of Chestertown, MD, Hugh McAllister of Oxford, PA. and James McAllister of New Castle, DE., One daughter Kelly Mullins of Elkton, MD, One brother, Michael McAllister and wife Barbara of Elkton, MD. He is also survived by six grandchildren, Chase, Adam , Kirsten and Shelby McAllister as well as Chuck & Jamie Mullins. Also a host of friends including Bob, Wendy, Danielle & Mattie Bakeoven of Millington, MD.
