October 22, 1929 - January 15, 2013

Andrew (Andy) Sweetak passed away on January 15 2013, at Memorial Hospital Easton, MD. He was 83 years old.

Andy was born October 22, 1929, in Nesquehoning, PA, to the late Nadya and Andrew Sweetak. Andy is the last of the original Sweetak's born to his Russian immigrant parents.

After high school, Andy enlisted in the Navy at 17 and was honorably discharged in 1950. He then joined the Metropolitan DC Police Department. After retirement from the department, Andy moved his family to Easton. He worked for short periods in real estate, building houses, as a bank messenger, and many other endeavors. He permanently retired at age 62.

Andy was a life member of the Association of Retired DC Police. He was also a life member of Elk's Lodge #1622. He served two terms as cabinet secretary for District 22B of Lions Club International.

He was preceded in death by Harriet, the love of his life and his wife of 56 years. Andy and Harriet met while they worked at the Metropolitan DC Police Department.

He is survived by his daughter, Rea Everitt of Gordonsville, VA; his sons and

daughter-in-laws, Drew and Jackie and Alex and Beth of Millington MD; grandchildren, Kim Everitt (a Harvard Law graduate and resident of London England), Chris Everitt of Richmond, VA, and Jack and Grace Sweetak of Millington.
