Angela Sheaffer Barilar passed away Saturday July 31, 2010 at home. She was 51.

Born October 15, 1958 in Hyannis, Massachusetts she was the daughter of Peter and Shirley Sheaffer of Centreville, MD. She graduated from Barnstable High School in Massachusetts and from North Dakota State University Equine Studies Program.

In addition to her parents she is survived by her loving husband of 24 years, John; her daughter, Larrissa; sister, Sandy Sheaffer; mother-in-law, Doris Barilar; brother and sister-in-law, Bruce and Karen Barilar. She is also survived by two nephews, Austin and Madison and a niece, Jackie.

Angela, owner of High Point Hanoverians, was a pioneer in the importing of Warmblood Sport Horses from Europe to this country and over the years developed one of the top Sport Horse breeding programs in North America. Angela's incredible eye for high quality horses and insightful nature in the Sport Horse breeding industry led to numerous honors, achievements and awards. She heavily influenced the Sport Horse breeding programs across this nation. She was always supremely professional, kind and supportive of her fellow breeders. Angela was always quick with a smile and positively influenced the Sport Horse world.

A very talented light may have gone out but, her legacy will live on through her family, friends, her business partner, Klaus Schengber and most of all her horses.
