



## Angus W. MacDonald

April 27, 1921 - October 8, 2011

Hagerstown, MD – Angus W. MacDonald, Sr. of Hagerstown, MD formerly of Chester, MD. died Saturday October 8, 2011 at Somerford Place in Hagerstown, MD. He was 90.

Born in Mt. Sidney, VA on April 27, 1921, he was the son of the late Angus D. and Etta Pritchard MacDonald. He grew up in Berwyn, and graduated from McKinley Tech High School in the class of 1940. On February 3, 1941, he joined the U.S. Army. During WWII he served in the Pacific Theater in Guada Canal, New Georgia, Fiji Islands, Bouganville and Luzon Islands. After WWII, he worked as an auto mechanic for Ford Motor Co. in Hyattsville, MD. Mr. MacDonald then farmed from 1950 until 1962 in Sharpsburg, MD, until going to work for Mack Truck in Hagerstown, MD. He retired in 1982. He was a past member of the Kent Island American Legion Post #278 and the Grasonville V.F.W. 7464.

He is survived by two daughters, Sandra M. Graumann of Mineral, VA and Barbara M. Dante of Sharpsburg, MD; one son, Angus W. MacDonald, jr of Sharpsburg, MD; and two granddaughters, Jennifer of New Orleans, LA and Kimberly of Chantilly, VA. He was predeceased by his granddaughter Tracy Graumann (2011) and sister, Jane C. Rankin (1998).

A memorial service will be held at Arlington National Cemetery at a later date.
