Ann Penelope Bain passed away on Wednesday, February 20, 2019, at home in the loving care of her family. Born in Tanzania, British East Africa, she was the daughter of the late Major Peter France and Eileen Marian Wilmer-Hives Chandor.

Ann grew up in England during WWII before coming in the United States in the 1950's to work in Baltimore, and then later moving to Woodstock, VA, to breed and show bull mastiffs with her father. She would travel back and forth to England often until her marriage in London, England in 1957 to the late Dr. Callum R.W. Bain. They lived in North Carolina and Texas, where she had worked as a teacher, before settling in Easton, MD, in 1967.

She is survived by her son, John Peter Chandor Bain of Veneta, OR and his wife, Melissa, and their two sons, Carson and Nathan; and her daughter, Mary Bain Windsor of Easton and her husband, Mike, and their two children, Michael and Samantha. Besides her parents and her husband, she is preceded in death by her brother, Anthony P. Chandor; her sister, Valerie Fleur Chandor Moody; and her nephew, James Andrew Moody, all of England.

We corresponded occasionally.

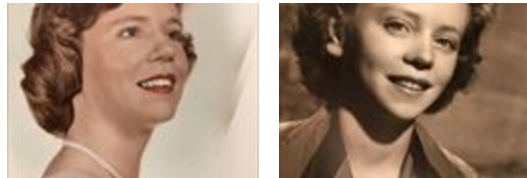
