Ann Gilbert Christ, 85, of Trappe, MD, died peacefully on Wednesday, January 6, 2016, at her home in Trappe. She was born in Manhattan, NY, on October 28, 1930, daughter of the late Russell L. Gilbert and Geraldine Payne.

Mrs. Christ grew up in Manhattan and Long Island, NY, along with her sister, Jane Womble, before moving to Trappe in 1992. She was always active and energetic, bringing a ray of sunshine to everything she touched. She became fluent in French at a very young age, later spending time in France and throughout Europe where she developed a lifelong love of the arts. Her passion for the arts later led her to the study of design and creation of her own interior design firm. She was a committed and long-time volunteer with Catholic Charities in New York and Maryland. She was an active member of the Federated Garden Club, The Colony and Piping Rock Clubs in New York, as well as the Harbor Club in Easton. She enjoyed sailing, golfing, painting, and needlework.

She is survived by her husband of 60 years, the Honorable M. Hallsted Christ, retired Justice of the New York State Supreme Court and former Comptroller of Nassau County, NY. She is further survived by her four children, Marcus, Geraldine, John, and Marion, as well as eight grandchildren.
