



## Ann Paterson Harris

June 30, 1922 - April 28, 2019

Ann Paterson Harris passed away peacefully on Sunday, April 28, 2019, at HeartFields Assisted Living in Easton, MD, at the age of 96. She was a resident of Easton and formerly of Potomac, MD. She was predeceased by her husband of 58 years, Carl A. Harris.

Mr. Harris was a World War II veteran, FBI Special Agent, and an attorney who founded Carl A. Harris and Associates. She was a graduate of the University of Maryland and a member of the Kappa Kappa Gamma sorority, the Oxford United Methodist Church, and the Potomac United Methodist Church. She worked at the Associated Press, Baltimore Bureau, was the author of *The Potomac Adventure* and a columnist for the *Potomac Gazette*. She loved her book club, tending to her numerous flower beds – especially her rose garden -- and held a special place in her heart for Bethany Beach, DE, where she enjoyed many summer vacations with children and grandchildren.
