Ann Schauber Jacquette of Rock Hall, MD died Sunday, October 3, 2010 at Chester River Manor in Chestertown, MD. She was 85.

Ann S. Jacquette was born July 14, 1925 in Chestertown, MD the daughter of the late Bradford Schauber and Frances "Myers" Schauber. Mrs. Jacquette helped raise her brother and three sisters while helping on her family dairy farm. Mrs. Jacquette was a 1944 graduate of Chestertown High School. After high school she delivered milk for her father, owner of Schauber's Dairy. While delivering milk she met her husband James Warner Jacquette and the two were married in 1947.
