Ann Malee Warner of Centreville, MD, died suddenly in a motor vehicle accident on August 24, 2000, in Price, MD. She was 31.

She attended school in Rockville and was a graduate of Rockville High School Class of 1986. She attended Towson University and later transfer to the University of Delaware where she received her B.S. in Dietetics & Nutrition.
