Ann Larrimore Morris of Queen Anne, Maryland died on Saturday, October 27, 2012 at Easton Memorial Hospital. She was 75.

Born on August 3, 1937 on Bookers Wharf Farm now known as Camp Pecometh, Maryland, she was the daughter of the late, James Buck and Erma Powell Larrimore. After graduating from Centreville High School, Ann worked as an operator for C&P in Easton for twenty years.
