Ann Montague Miller Wachenfeld of Chestertown, Md. died on Saturday, November 9, 2002. She was 72.

Born on October 12, 1930 in Orange, New Jersey she was the daughter of the late Spencer Miller, Jr. and Margaret Geer Miller. Growing up in Orange, she attended Miss Beard's School for Girls, graduating in 1948. Mrs. Wachenfeld then attended Mount Holyoke College in Hadley, Massachusetts, graduating in 1952. She married Richard Wachenfeld in 1956, after spending several years working in New York. They had three children; Douglas, Margaret and Peter and lived for many years in Fair Haven, N.J. before moving to Wallingford, Pennsylvania. They retired to Chestertown, Md. in 1992.

Throughout her life Mrs. Wachenfeld dedicated herself to helping others through her many volunteer activities. She helped children with developmental disabilities, working with KART (the Kent Association for Riding Therapy) and several other organizations for the developmentally disabled. She volunteered in several hospitals, locally with Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital. Mrs. Wachenfeld also served on the board of Directors of Horizon and local programs for children. As an active member of the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown, Ann sang in the choir and served as Deacon. One of her proudest achievements was introducing both illiterate adults and children with learning disabilities to the joys of reading. She was an active member of the Chestertown community and will be missed by many friends and family far

and wife. She is survived by her husband, her children and seven grandchildren: Kimberly, Rebekah, Melissa, Timothy, Amy Wachenfeld and Alexander and Nicholas Jessen.
