Anna Lisa Burns of Centreville, MD, was received into the loving arms of God on January 26, 2016, at the University of MD Medical Center. She was 56.

Born on January 13, 1960, in Chestertown, MD, she was the daughter of the late Charles and Roxie Sewell Hawkins. She grew up in Centreville and graduated from Queen Anne's County High School in 1978.
