Anna Langohr of Chester died Friday January 19, 2007 at her daughter's home in Grasonville, MD. She was 95.

Born in Aberdeen area of Baltimore County, MD on June 22, 1911, the daughter of the late Joseph and Anna Stipek. She later moved to the Overlea area of Baltimore, MD. Mrs. Langohr worked as a governess in Park Heights, tending to small children. On June 15, 1930, she married Charles Henry Langohr of South Baltimore. Mrs. Langohr raised her family in the Baltimore area and worked as a cook in the cafeteria of Lock Raven Elementary School for over ten years. In 1965, they moved to Chester, MD. Mr. Langohr died in 1980. She was a member of the New Life Christian Outreach Church in Chester, MD, the Homemaker's of America and the American Association of Retired People.
