



## Anna Mae Marsh

Anna Mae Marsh, 79, of Cambridge, MD, passed away at her home peacefully on Saturday, February 7, 2015, with her family by her side.

Born on September 27, 1935, she was the daughter of Joseph and Stella Mills Willey of Swards and was the sister of Ruth Evans of Ocean Pines, Levi Willey, Sr. of Fruitland and Guy Willey, Sr. of Cambridge.

Anna Mae enjoyed her life. She was a loving and devoted mother who loved her family. She loved taking day trips, especially day trips to play slots. She enjoyed cooking and taking care of her family. She was a member of the St. Paul's United Methodist Church in Cambridge for 50 years. She was a member of the Giggles Group and also the Joy Group at her church. Later, she enjoyed listening to the many churches on the local radio station in Cambridge.
