



Anna Virginia Rider

February 22, 1928 - January 16, 2018

Anna V. Rider of Centreville, MD, died after a long battle with cancer at Compass Regional Hospice on January 16, 2018. She was 89.

Born in Church Hill, MD, on February 22, 1928, she was the daughter of the late Thomas Green and Ethel Cronshaw Green. She attended Church Hill High School, graduating in the Class of 1945. She was a Telephone Operator, Bank Teller and worked for local retail companies in the area. On May 31, 1946, she married Charles W. Rider, and the couple made their home in Sudlersville, MD, until later moving to Centreville. Her husband predeceased her suddenly in 1963, after 13 years of marriage.

Mrs. Rider was a member of the Barclay United Methodist Church and AARP. She enjoyed working in the yard and gardening as well as playing bingo with her friends at Tilghman Terrace. She greatly enjoyed visiting with cousins, nieces, and grandchildren.

She is survived by her two children, Charles Rider, Jr. (Beverly) and Thomas Rider (Maela); grandchildren, Charles Rider, III, Marcia Bozarth, Thomas N. Rider (Ashley), Marisa Jacobs (Blake) and Gene Generalao (Mel); and great-grandchildren Abigail Bozarth, Aubrey Davis, Cadence, Hudson Jacobs, Felipa and Emilian Generalao. In addition to her husband, Charles, she had three sisters: Mary C. Clough, Jean Leager and Ethel Green; one brother,

Arthur M. Green; and one granddaughter, Barbie Rider who predeceased her.
