Anna Slingbaum Riley of Millington, MD, passed away Sunday, June 14, 2020, at her home in Millington, MD. She was 78.

Anna S. Riley was born on July 10, 1941, in Haddonfield, NJ, the daughter of the late Catherine Alexander and William Slingbaum. She attended school in Cecilton, MD, and began working at Silcos in Middletown as a sales clerk. She later began a career as a sewing machine operator, working for Leeds Travel, making luggage, for 13 years. She then began working at Clariant in the shipping and receiving department for 13 years, later returning to her career as a sewing machine operator for Harris's. On Feb. 4, 2000, she married Russell J. Riley, Jr., and resided in Millington.
