Anna Kathryn Schwaninger Ebling, 85, of Easton MD, died peacefully at home in Talbot County on Monday, April 16, 2018.

Born in 1933 in Easton, Md., she graduated from Easton High School and attended Bridgewater College in Virginia.

In 1953, she married Dudley Ebling. They had three children: Jo, Richard, and Kat; and farmed for many years in Caroline County. Ann was also payroll and accounts payable clerk at Saulsbury Brothers Inc. in Ridgely, MD, for 24 years before her retirement.

She was active in the Whitemarsh Homemakers Club in Talbot County, Farm Bureau Discussion Group #6; and the Easton High School Reunion 1951 Committee. She served in many roles at Ridgely and Peachblossom (Easton) Church of the Brethren over the years, dedicating herself to music and worship, choral music, outdoor ministries at Camp Mardela, and church district activities before and after retirement.

Ann enjoyed an eclectic multitude of interests including music, antiques, nutrition, canasta, home decorating, hymnology, family historian, genealogy, creative writing, reading and maintaining family and friendship networks.

Ann is predeceased by her husband, Dudley, of 46 years. She is survived by her three children: Jo, Rick (Wan), Kat; four grandchildren: Rebecca, Danial, Nathan and Ada; her sister Fran; her brother Dan (Betty), many nieces and nephews, and numerous friends.
