Anna Virginia Scott passed away on January 13, 2026 at Arcadia of Denton, MD. She was 92 years old.

She was born on August 27, 1933 in Millington, MD, the daughter of the late John T. Lockwood and Anna (Christopher) Lockwood. She was the proud owner of her own business, BNV Ceramics, where her love of art and crafting came to life.
