Anna I. Lednum, of Bozman, went home to be with Jesus at Talbot Hospice House on Saturday, November 11, 2006. She was 76.

Born in Baltimore on November 10, 1930 she was the daughter of the late William and Hattie Hunt Wales. After attending public school in Baltimore, she and her family moved to Bozman, where in 1947 she married Leroy Lednum a Talbot county waterman and house painter. A homemaker for most of her life she had in later years worked at the Wades Point Inn at McDaniel, until retiring due to health reasons. Mr. Lednum died in November 1986

Mrs. Lednum was a member of the First Wesleyan Church of Easton where she taught Sunday school, was an accomplished soloist, and had the vision and was instrumental in the construction of the Christmas float.

She is survived by her daughter Lynn Richardson and her husband Alvin of Bozman; two grandchildren Heidi Richardson of Bozman; Alvin Richardson III and his wife Misty of Easton; four great grandchildren Stephen, Natalie, Julia, and Philip; and many nieces and nephews. In addition to her husband she was preceded in death by five sisters and two brothers.
