Lynette T. Burton of Centreville, MD died after a lengthy illness on Sunday, March 4, 2007 at the Chester River Hospital. She was 85 years old.

Lynette Burton was born on November 27, 1921 in Chester, MD to the late Edward H. Timms and Elizabeth Lewis. She was a 1938 graduate of Stevensville High. In 1939 she married Samuel Phillip Burton and they resided on Kent Island, where they raised their two children.

In 1957, Mrs. Burton began working at the Stevensville Bank and Denny's Garage as a bookkeeper. In 1979, they began spending their winters in Florida. In 1983 Mr. Burton predeceased her. Ms Burton later resided in Centreville, MD where she worked at The Pottery in Queenstown and Peeble's in Chestertown. Mrs. Burton was a volunteer at the Centreville Senior Center and member of the Crumpton United Methodist Church.

Mrs. Burton is survived by her son, Charles Edward Burton of Centreville, MD and her daughter, Phyllis Burton Meier of Easton, MD; six grandchildren, Jay Burton, Gail Benton Donnelly, Lahoma Ann Burton, Scott Benton, Craig Burton, and Barbara Meier and 12 great-grandchildren. She is predeceased by her husband, Samuel Phillip Burton; 3 sisters, Sadie Chance, Margaret Chance and Edna Finnemore; and one grandson, Jeffrey Edward Burton.
