Anna M. Pratt, of Bozman, died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton on Wednesday, December 18, 2002. She was 84.

Born in Cumberland, MD, August 22, 1918, she was the daughter of the late Dr. Thomas B. and Nona Millholland McDonald. A resident of Talbot County since 1970, she was a member of the Talbot Country Club, the Miles River Yacht Club, the Poplar Island Yacht Club and attended St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton. 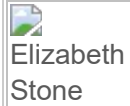
