A Funeral Liturgy for Anna Mae Rash will be celebrated at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, Easton on Thursday, April 18, 2002 at 2:00 PM. Mrs. Rash died at Memorial Hospital at Easton on Sunday, April 14, 2002.

Born in Talbot County August 6, 1918, she was one of thirteen children of the late James Leo, Sr. and Ethel Rhodes Gannon. After graduating from Cordova High School in 1935, she received her nursing degree from St. Agnes Hospital in Baltimore in 1941. In 1945 she began a lifelong career in the nursing profession until retiring in 1982 from Memorial Hospital at Easton.

She was a member of Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, Easton.

Mrs. Rash is survived by her husband, James W. Rash, whom she married March 17, 1942; a daughter, Dolores V. Sard of Preston; a son, James H.
