Ann C. Anthony of Queenstown, MD died on Friday, July 29, 2011 at home surrounded by her loving family. She was 82.

Born August 19, 1928 near Queenstown, MD, she was the daughter of the late, Herman and Lillian Larrimore Comegys. She graduated from Centreville High School in 1945 and attended Beacom Business College in Wilmington, DE. She began her career working with the Friel Lumber Company where she met and later married Joseph Franklin Anthony on June 23, 1951. They resided in Queenstown, MD. Ann later went to work for the Queenstown Bank as a bookkeeper from 1967-1986.

Throughout her life, she enjoyed spending time with her family, playing cards, traveling and crafts.

Mrs. Anthony is survived by two daughters, Jo Ann A. Powell and her husband, Royden of Centreville, MD and Jane Anthony of Chestertown, MD; a son, Jeff Anthony and his wife, Susan of Queenstown, MD; a brother, John Comegys of Centreville, MD; four grandchildren, Nathan Powell, J.P.
