



Anne Elizabeth Hock

August 12, 1930 - January 29, 2025

Anne Elizabeth (Allbeury) Hock, of Trappe, passed away on January 29, 2025.

Anne was born in Los Angeles, California on August 12, 1930, to Fredrick Leslie LeBoutlier Allbeury and Helen Macklin Allbeury. Growing up in Southern California, she studied music and art, concentrating on a career in music with studying art independently with Sister Corita Kent, Rex Brandt, and at the Otis Art Institute. She moved to New York, where she worked in advertising, and was chief designer for her national tennis fashion manufacturing company. In New York, she studied at the Art Students League and the National Art League, and attended workshops with Clyde Asperig, Ted Goerschner, Kenn Bookhaus, and the Plein Air Painters of America; all of which were instrumental in her development of the soft focus realism which she preferred. After moving to Talbot County, she was a founder of the Plein Air Painters of the Eastern Shore, and was a member of the California Art Club, the Mid-Atlantic Plein Air Painters Association, St. Michaels Art League, the Dorchester Arts Center, and the Academy Art Museum. Anne showed at many regional venues and conducted drawing and painting classes and workshops at the Academy Art Museum, the Dorchester Arts Center, and at her studio in Trappe, Maryland. She also lectured on plein air techniques and painted in plein air on the Eastern Shore, in California, Mexico and New England. Anne is survived by her children, Christina Azus, Kathleen Harris, and Patrick Mulligan.

A graveside service will be held on Thursday, February 13, 2025, at 2:00pm at the White Marsh Cemetery, Manadier Road, Trappe, MD.
