



## Anne Marion Warrington

August 8, 1924 - November 25, 2013

Anne Marion Warrington, our beloved Nana, passed away peacefully at the Pines in Easton on November 25, 2013. She was born on August 8, 1924, in New Rochelle, NY, to the late Pietro Abbate and Maria Teresa Ricci Abbate.

Anne grew up in New York and graduated from Mamaroneck High School in 1942. There she excelled in all sports and was even offered a full college scholarship to become a PE teacher. As a young adult, Anne worked in her father's grocery store. Later, as a beautiful hat-check girl at the Blue Haven Inn, Anne met the love of her life, Arthur Warrington (co-owner of Walter's Hot Dog Stand, where Anne eventually worked). The two were married on August 30, 1947, had two children, and lived happily ever after for over 59 years. Anne and Artie resided in Mamaroneck, NY, until 1974, when they moved to Whaleyville, MD, to live on her in-laws farm. In 2001, they moved to Easton to be closer to their family.

Anne was a loving and devoted wife, mother, Nana, aunt, sister, and friend. She enjoyed cooking, crocheting, listening to music, playing the accordion, piano, and harmonica. Anne also was an avid bowler, sang in the choir at St. Vito's Church, and participated as a member of the American Legion Auxiliary for over 60 years. She had such a kind spirit, generous heart, warm smile, comforting hugs, and will be deeply missed.

Nana was greeted in heaven by her husband, Artie Warrington; her son, Walter Warrington; and her seven brothers and sisters. She is survived by her daughter, Rosy Ball (Glenn); her two granddaughters, Kristy Ball and Dina Myers (Matt); two great-grandsons, Luke and Hudson; and close family friends, "Nana's Girls", Dot Plugge, Naomi Tribett, and Ruth Fluharty.

A funeral liturgy will be celebrated at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, 1210 S. Washington St., Easton, MD 21601 on Saturday, November 30, 2013, at 10 a.m, followed by a graveside service at Spring Hill Cemetery in Easton.

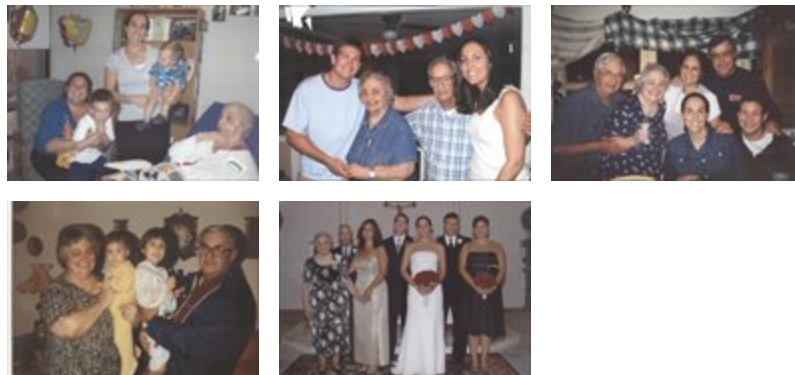

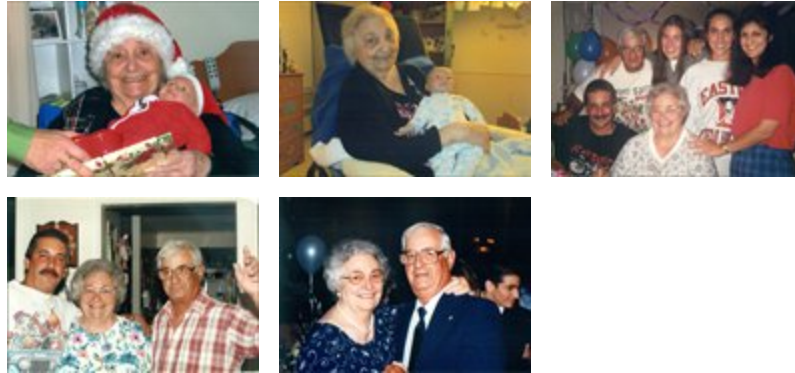
