Annebel F. Whitby, of Easton formerly of Bethlehem, died at the Genesis Eldercare- The Pines, Easton, on Friday, March 1, 2002. She was 87.

Born at Church Hill, October 21, 1914, she was the daughter of the late William and Mary Kathryn Weir Fogwell. As a child she moved to Kennedyville where she graduated from high school. She then attended nurses' training at the Memorial Hospital School of Nursing in Easton. On May 5, 1935, she married Charles L. Whitby, Jr., a Talbot County farmer later estate caretaker. They made their home on various farms in Caroline and Talbot Counties. Following his death in 1977, she continued to live in Talbot County until moving to Bethlehem in Caroline County in 1979.

Her hobbies included gardening and reading English History and romantic novels.

Mrs. Whitby is survived by a daughter, Mary Elizabeth (Betty) Corder of Garland, TX; a son, Charles A. Whitby of Trappe; a brother, William Fogwell of Iowa; six grandchildren, John C. Corder, Jeffrey C. Corder, Sandra E. Corder, Charles L. Whitby, III, Yvonne A. Ferrari and Tracy D. Fairall and four great-grandchildren. Another daughter, Clara W. Seigler, died January 5, 2001.
