



## Anne Graham Davis

Anne Leo Graham Davis, who was 100 years old on July 30, 2002, died December 27, 2002 in Easton MD. She had come to Washington DC in the early 1930s and maintained an abode here through 1994. At her death, Mrs. Davis was a resident of William Hill Manor in Easton.

Mrs. Davis was a graduate of St. Mary's College in Raleigh, NC, and the University of NC at Chapel Hill in 1927. She studied Journalism at Columbia University in New York. She was a Society Editor for the Durham Morning Herald. She also wrote freelance for papers in NC, Georgia, Chicago, and New York.

Mrs. Davis and her husband, the late Jackson C. Davis, maintained homes in Washington and Rehoboth, Delaware and Mrs. Davis was very active civically where ever she lived. In Washington, she was a member of the Board of Governors of The Women's National Democratic Club, and she also served as Chairman of the Memberhsip Committee, as treasurer and as recording secretary. During World War II, Mrs. Davis was in charge of the Club's Red Cross work. She was a member of the Sulgrave Club, of the North Carolina Committee of the "National Society of Colonial Dames of America", and the National Society of Magna Charta Dames. She was active in the campaign for the presidency waged by Presidents Roosevelt and Truman. She was Chairman of the Hospitality Committee of the American Newspapers

Women's Club and a member of Chi Omega Sorority.

In Rehoboth, she was a member of the Rehoboth Beach Country Club, The Rehoboth Art League and the Henlopen Acres Beach Club.

Mrs. Davis was a descendent of William A. Graham who was successively Secretary of the Navy, Governor of NC and a member of the United States Senate from NC.

Mrs. Davis is survived by numerous nieces and nephews.

Burial will be in Hillsboro, NC at a later date.
