Anne Lane Powell died April 28, 2010 at Atlantic General Hospital in Berlin, Maryland at 62 years of age.

Anne was born on January 27, 1948, the second child of Royden N. Powell, Jr. and Roxanna Lane Powell and grew up in Centreville with a love of horses, sailing and everything that life brought her way. She graduated from Centreville High School in 1966 and attended Winthrop College before earning her Bachelor of Arts degree from Virginia Commonwealth University in 1971, majoring in commercial art. Following employment with Hochschild-Kohn in Baltimore as a graphic artist, she settled in Worcester County to work for the Beachcomber newspaper and followed with a career in the restaurant industry.

Anne is survived by her sister, Jane Powell Coppage and husband, Marvin; a brother, Royden N. Powell III and wife, Jo-Ann; her friend, Roger E. Wagner II; 5 nieces and nephews; 8 great-nieces and nephews; her Labrador Rene, along with many, many close friends.
