Annemarie Agreen of Denton, MD, formerly of Easton, MD and Ormond Beach, FL, died on Wednesday, August 1, 2001 at Shore Nursing and Rehab, Denton, MD. She was 89.

Born in Hamburg, Germany, June 6, 1912, she was the daughter of the late Heinrich and Elsa Amos Eckloff. After graduating from high school in Germany, she came to the U.S. in 1930. She lived in NJ where she worked as a domestic and as a dental assistant before training as a nurses aide. She then became a house mother in an orphanage in East orange, NJ. In September 1940, she married Milton N. Agreen, an accountant and they made their home in Newark, NJ and Dumont, NJ and then Bergenfield, NJ before moving to Ormond Beach, FL in 1975. They moved to Maryland in July 1998.

Surviving in addition to her husband, are three sons, Robert C. Agreen of New Castle, DE, Russell W. Agreen of Denton, MD and Bruce H. Agreen of Jacksonville, FL; a brother, Henry Eckloff of Kenilworth, NJ; a sister, Ilsa Cohen of Manalapan, NJ; 7 grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, August 6, 2001 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, Easton where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
