Anne Sutherland Brenner, beloved wife, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, of Easton, MD, formerly of Oxford, MD died on Tuesday, June 21, 2005 at Genesis Eldercare-The Pines, Easton. She was 94.

Born April 27, 1911 in Brooklyn, New York, she was the daughter of the late William and Isabel Shearer Molloy. During the Depression she began her teaching career in a one room school house in Upstate New York. She later taught public school for the New York City School System in Brooklyn. After her retirement from public schools, she and her husband Albert, raised and raced standard bred race horses from their farm in Wallkill, New York. After moving to Oxford, MD in 1989, they continued to race standard bred horses for a few years.

Mrs. Brenner is survived by her husband of 70 years, Albert Brenner, whom she married in 1934; a daughter, Wendy Bishop and her husband Edward, Jr. of Oxford, MD; four grandchildren, Vicki Darnell and her husband Rick of Orange, CA, Edward Bishop III and his wife Edith of Easton, Gerald Brenner, and Dr. Alan Bishop and his wife Georgiana all of Oxford; and three great-grandchildren, Benjamin Brenner, Kendall Bishop and Samuel Bishop. She was predeceased by a son, U.S. Army Warrant Officer 4, Donald Robert Brenner who died in 1988 and a grandson, Donald Robert Brenner, Jr.
