



Ann Grechko Roesler

December 12, 1921 - February 7, 2010

Ann Roesler, 88, of Annapolis, MD, passed away at her residence on Sunday, February 7, 2010. Ann was born in Hartford, CT on December 12, 1921 and is the daughter of the late Frank Grechko and Mary (Klos) Grechko, the third eldest of their eight children.

Ann was a graduate of Hartford public schools, Columbia University, and the University of Minnesota, receiving a bachelor's degree in early childhood education in 1946. She moved to Annapolis with her ex-husband, the late Gordon Roesler, when he was recalled to active duty in the United States Navy and assigned as an instructor at the United States Naval Academy in 1950. She resided in Annapolis, in the house that Gordon built, for the rest of her life. She was an elementary school teacher, first in Linthicum, MD, then at West Annapolis Elementary School, and at the Naval Academy Primary School. She continued to be active in educational matters for many years, including being president of West Annapolis PTA in the 1960s. She was a past member of the College Women's Club of Annapolis and of the Navy League of the United States. Her favorite pastimes were gardening and the game of bridge, which she enjoyed throughout her life. She was also very involved and committed to conservative causes, and cared passionately about the history and the future of the United States.

Ann is survived by her two sons, Gordon Merriam Roesler, Jr. of Marina del

Rey, CA and Robert David Roesler of Burke, VA; six grandchildren, Hope, Benjamin, David, Melissa, Thomas and Laura; her brother, Kenneth Grechko of Glastonbury, CT and her sister, Elizabeth Wootton of San Diego, CA.

A celebration of Ann's life will be held at a later date. Interment will be private.
