August 24, 1928 - August 22, 2015

Annie May Culley of Rock Hall, MD, died on Saturday August 22, 2015, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Chestertown. She was 86.

She was born in Baltimore on August 24, 1928, the daughter of the late Wilbur Hill Jordan, Sr., and Grace Mae Bosley Jordan Beck. She attended school in Ft. Wayne, IN.

In 1945, she moved to Rock Hall, MD, where she met and married James N. Culley, Sr., better known as "Puggy" on November 24, 1948. They lived in Rock Hall where she raised her family and worked as she put it, "a damn good waitress" at Chesapeake Restaurant until their closing. She enjoyed bowling, picking crabs, and watching Orioles baseball. She was a member of Sgt. Preston Ashely American Legion Post #228 Ladies Auxiliary in Rock Hall.

She is survived by a son, James Nelson Culley, Jr., of Rock Hall, MD; a daughter, Edith Ann Culley Elbourn of Chestertown, MD; two brothers, Wilbur Hill Jordan, Jr., of OK, and William B. Jordan, III, of South FL; grandchildren, James Jordan Elbourn and Nicole Elizabeth Elbourn both of Chestertown, MD, and Samantha Joanne Elbourn Seago of Chicago, IL; along with five great-grandchildren.
