



Annie Lou Schweitzer

June 11, 1924 - January 26, 2010

Annie “Lou” Schweitzer nee Collins died Tuesday, January 26, 2010 at the Hospice of Queen Anne’s Hospice Center in Centreville. She was 85.

Born on June 11, 1924 to Carrie Elizabeth Harper and Columbus David Collins in Wilmont, Arkansas, Lou was brought up in McGehee and Parkdale. After graduating from Parkdale High School, she worked in the restaurant business for several years. In March of 1950 she enlisted in the Women’s Army Corp and was honorably discharged in March of 1953. She married John C. Schweitzer on April 12, 1958 in Washington, D.C. She was employed by Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company, working in the Bell System for 30 years before retiring with perfect attendance and moving to Florida.

Lou’s hobbies included reading, latch hook, and doing word puzzle books. She moved to Maryland in 1999 and has lived in Queenstown since then. She was a member of the Kent Island First Baptist Church. Mrs. Schweitzer was a member of the Theta Beta Sigma Phi sorority in Daytona Beach, Florida.

She is survived by her husband, John C. Schweitzer; brother-in-law, James W. Schweitzer of Levels, West Virginia; sister-in-laws, Jean S. Mead. Joellen S. Bailey, Joy Pucciarelli and Ina Collins of Lynchburg, Virginia and various nephews and nieces. She leaves her four-legged friend “Bailey” to her

husband's care. She is preceded in death by nine brothers and sisters.
