Anthony Andrew Natalini, of Bridgepoint, PA, passed away on Sunday, March 11, 2018, at his daughter's home in Chestertown, MD. He was 86.

Born on November 28, 1931, in Norristown, PA, he was the son of the late Albert and Mary Paciello Natalini. He graduated from Norristown High School, Class of 1949. He was drafted into the United States Army, and served for two years until he was honorably discharged in 1954.
