Anthony Ramont "P-Nutt" Kennard, Sr. passed away on February 28, 2026 at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Chestertown. He was 53 years old.

He was born on July 4, 1972 in Chestertown, MD, the son of Arthur Ray Kennard and Mitzi Saunders. He graduated from Kent County High School with the class of 1990, where he played football. P-Nutt was talented in the kitchen, and worked various food service jobs around Chestertown, including at Washington College and the Lemon Leaf Café.

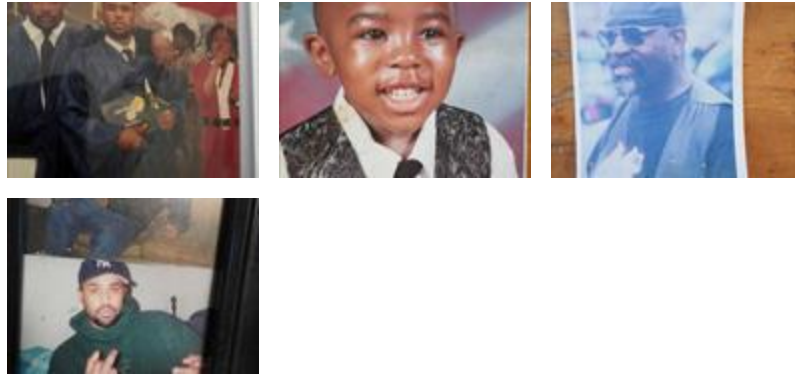
