Dr. Anthony (Tony) P. Mazarek of Stevensville, MD, passed away on Jan 7, 2023. Born on February 11, 1941, in West Allis, WI, he was the youngest child of six to Michael and Catherine Mazarek.

Dr. Mazarek graduated from University of Wisconsin Madison Medical School and served as a Captain and Psychiatrist in the US Army during the Vietnam War until being honorably discharged in 1971.
