A. Paul Cross of Easton, died at the Talbot Hospice House, Easton, on Monday, February 16, 2009. He was 89.

Born in Berkeley Springs, West Virginia on February 4, 1920, he was the son of the late, Alonzo W. Cross and Sarah M. Roach Cross. He attended school in Baltimore, Maryland and served in the U.S. Army from 1943 to 1945. Upon returning home from military service, he went into business with his brother as a general contractor, and then worked for the U.S. Post Office in Baltimore for one year. In 1950, he began working for the Army Corps of Engineers as a mechanical engineer, where he remained for 30 years. After retiring in 1980, he moved to Kent Island.

He married Margaret Streets in 1940; she died in 1958. He married again in 1960 to Catherine Schmidt, who died in 1996. In 1997, he married Anna D. Morton, and they resided in Easton, Maryland. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge #180 Centreville.

Mr. Cross has three children, Paul Cross, Jr., Peggy Fox and Genevieve Timmons; one sister, Christine Slaughter; two step-children, Edward Morton and Sherrie Morton, and numerous grandchildren.

Home on Monday, February 23, 2009 at 11:00 a.m., where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
