



Aprille Lynn McKee-Wright

April 2, 1943 - June 14, 2024

Aprille Lynn McKee-Wright, 81, of Royal Oak, MD, formerly of St. Pete Beach, FL and Keyser, WV, passed away peacefully on June 14, 2024, after a six month struggle with bone cancer. She was preceded in death by her father, Donald McKee, her mother, Margaret Taylor, and her dear son, Aron McKee-Wright.

Born in Keyser on April 2, 1943, Aprille was a small town girl gifted with great natural beauty and unaffected charm. After graduating Keyser High School, she attended the University of Florida in Gainesville, ultimately settling in St. Pete Beach, where she taught in area schools and then became a social worker.

In the early 1970s, Aprille's adventuresome nature led her to travel extensively around America, including New England, where she met her future husband. In 1977, they settled on his family farm on the Eastern Shore, where she became a devoted mother and homemaker, an avid gardener, and a school/community activist.

Surviving are her husband of 47 years, Campbell Wright of Royal Oak, her beautiful daughter Piper McKee-Wright of San Diego, CA, and her ever-doting brother Brad Taylor of Vero Beach, FL. Surviving in addition are the wonderful extended families of the Wrights and Murrays, and the many close friends she

made, all of whom were touched by Aprille's generous, unique and engaging spirit.
