Arch W. Henry of Grasonville, MD died Wednesday, December 3, 2003 at his home. He was 77.

Born on April 9, 1926 in Union City, NJ, he was the son of the late Arch William Henry and Elsie Regan. He attended Dickenson High School in New Jersey until he was 17 and enlisted in the U.S. Navy. He served in the South Pacific as a signalman 3rd class on the U.S.S. Bataan Aircraft Carrier and was honorably discharged in 1946. He then enlisted in the merchant marines until he attended Wagner College in New York. He graduated class of 1952. He then began his career in sales. Working for Warner Electric in Wisconsin and later for IMO Delaval. He retired in the early 1990's as Vice President of sales. Arch moved to Grasonville in 1996.

He was a member of MISCA, Prospect Bay Country Club, Bay County Moose Lodge #831 and Alpha Sigma Phi. While residing in New Jersey, Arch was a long time member of Hopewell Valley Golf Club.
