



## Arden Fields

Arden A. Fields, Jr. of Stevensville, MD died on Monday, March 8, 2004 at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD. He was 79.

Born on April 15, 1924 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Arden Alvin Fields, SR and Marie Daum. Arden attended school in Baltimore, MD and following high school he enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corps and served three years, earning the rank of Corporal. He then began working for Baltimore Gas and Electric as a Steel Worker, working there 35 years until his retirement in 1979. He married Mary Rose Fields on April 9, 1950 in Baltimore County and they made their home in Brooklyn Park, MD until 1976 when they moved to Kent Island.

Arden enjoyed crabbing and was known for his cooking, especially his fruit cakes and crab soup. He was a member of the Grasonville Moose Lodge; American Legion; VFW; Island Islanders and was a Scout Master with Boy Scout Troop 188 while living in Baltimore. He will always be remembered as a loving husband and father.

Mr. Fields is survived by his wife, Mary Rose Fields; sons Arden A. Fields III of Severna Park, MD and Joseph Fields, Stewartstown, PA; daughters, Ann Williams, Queenstown, MD, Peggy Soriono, Abingdon, MD and Rose Ferrin of Columbia, MD; a sister, Margaret Rider of Baltimore, MD and nine

grandchildren. He is preceded in death by a sister, Pauline Shaw.

A funeral service will be held 11 am on Friday, March 12, 2004 at St. Christopher's Catholic Church in Stevensville, MD. The family will receive friends on Wednesday from 6-8 pm and Thursday 2-4 and 6-8 pm at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Chester, MD.

Burial will be in Cedar Hill Cemetery, Brooklyn Park, MD.
