Arden W. Somers died on May 19, 2013, at the Talbot Hospice House after an extended illness. She was 83.

Arden was born on May 6, 1930, in Ridgewood, NJ, to the late, Marjorie Blair Weyde and Herbert Louis Weyde. She graduated from Emma Willard School in June of 1948 and Skidmore College in June of 1952.

On June 14, 1952, she married Reynolds Somers, and they settled in Wyckoff, NJ, later moving to Saddle River, NJ, and then to Hohokus, NJ. She taught art in public and private schools before retiring to raise a family. It was always Arden's dream to retire to the Eastern Shore, so in 1991, she and Reyn bought property in Easton and built their dream home.

Arden will be deeply missed by all who knew her. She was a woman of many talents and interests including creating art, ice skating, playing the piano, reading, and playing bridge. She volunteered for many years at the Easton Art Academy, the Historical Society, and the Hospital Auxiliary. She was a member of the Talbot Country Club, the Harbor Club, and St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton.

Arden was a wonderful wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. She is lovingly survived by her husband of 60 years, Reynolds; her children,
