Arron L. "Al" Rizo of Preston died at the Mallard Bay Nursing and Rehab Center in Cambridge on Wednesday, January 14, 2004. He was 70.

Born in Texas City, Texas on December 12, 1933, he was the son of the late Ignacio and Minnie Garza Rizo. He attended the Bryan Military Academy in Texas City, and then graduated from Texas City High School. In 1951 he enlisted in the U.S. Navy. Following his release from active duty in 1955, he came to Maryland, where he lived in the Joppa area of Harford County where he worked as a high voltage electrician for the Maryland Transit Authority until his retirement in the mid 1990's.

A resident of Caroline County since 1985, he enjoyed hunting, fishing and just being outdoors. Since his retirement, he frequently would take vegetables from the eastern shore to different Baltimore area markets for resale.

In addition to his wife, the former Dorothy L. "Dottie" Rizo (nee Jones) whom he married in 1985, Mr. Rizo is survived by four children; Bruce "Mark" Rizo of Baltimore, MD; Dawn P. Kline of Joppa, MD; Brian C. Reckitt of Trappe, MD; Joe Reckitt of Texas City, TX; five grandchildren, Nick, Kyle, Taylor, Marisa and Clay. He is also survived by five sisters and one brother. In addition to his parents, he was also predeceased by a sister.

A Third Degree Mason, he was a member of the Highland Lodge #184 AF&AM, Baltimore.
