Arthur Lomax, son of the late James Earl Lomax and Mary Elizabeth Gibson Lomax, was born on July 9, 1931 in Chestertown, MD. God sent his angels at his home on April 14, 2024 surrounded by his family.

Arthur received his education from Henry Highland Garnet School of Chestertown. After graduating from Garnet, he served in the United States Army from May 7, 1952 to April 19, 1954 with honorable release from active duty while serving in Germany. After his release from service he began his construction career under the Laborers Local 199 of Wilmington, DE, where he worked for 30 years until his retirement.

In 1977, he married the love of his life, Barbara Kennard Lomax, and gained a son, Gary. Arthur cared deeply for his family, including his dogs. He will be remembered as a loving husband and someone who could always make you laugh. He was always in good humor. He enjoyed watching football, basketball, and baseball.
