Arthur "Allen" Whittier of Chestertown, MD died Monday, March 2, 2009.

Allen Whittier was born May 11, 1938 in Portsmouth, VA the son of the late Arthur Whittier and Lillian Lamont. Mr. Whittier served his country in the U.S. Marine Corp during the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged after four years of service. Mr. Whittier graduated from Norview High School in Norfolk, VA and excelled in athletics throughout his life. The Whittier award is now given to the athlete of the year at Norview High School in his honor. He was named All Norfolk in basketball and baseball as well as All American in football in High School. He was All American in football at Virginia Tech as well as Virginia State player of the year in 1960. Mr. Whittier played Professional Football for the New Orleans Saints and the Hamilton Tiger Cats in Hamilton Canada in the 1960's. Football was his life! In addition to coaching for Queen Anne's County High School, he started a little league football program in Kempsville, VA that is still ongoing today. He enjoyed gardening, cutting wood, helping his wife with her crafts, coaching football, traveling and working on continuing American football in Puerto Vallarta for under privileged boys.

He is survived by his wife, "Polly" Tarbutton of Chestertown, MD, two daughters, Stephanie Whittier of New York City, Susann Whittier of Richmond, VA, two sons, Scott Whittier of Bethesda, MD, Stephen Whittier of Daytona

Beach, FL, two sisters, Pat Hoffman of Virginia Beach, VA, BeBe Buck of Sarasota, FL and six grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held Saturday, March 7, 2009 at 1pm at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home 130 Speer Rd Chestertown, MD.
