Arthur Edward Southard of Gainesville, FL, formerly of Easton, MD died at his home on September 1, 2006. He was 87.

Born in Bloomingdale, NJ on January 9, 1919, he was the son of the late Arthur and Florence L. Horn Southard. He graduated from Stevensville High School, Class of 1936. He worked as a purser for the Old Love Point Ferry System and as a bookkeeper for A.C. Harris Seafood Company in Grasonville, MD. In 1939 he went to Baltimore, MD and worked for the Amos Co. while studying at night school to become a C.P.A. After World War II he went to Easton, MD and opened his own business as the first practicing C.P.A. in Talbot County, MD. He closed his business and to become the comptroller of Old Salt Seafood Co. He retired in 1990 and in 2003 he moved to Gainesville, FL.

Mr. Southard joined the Easton Rotary Club in 1951 where he became a Paul Harris Fellow. He served as Treasurer from 1952 until 1976 and received the Club Service Award in 1984 and the Presidents Award in 1996. Mr. Southard also served as scout master for many years for Boy Scout Troop #147 in St. Michaels, MD. He enjoyed camping in the mountains and at Chincoteague Island. He loved music and painting landscapes.

Mr. Southard is survived by a sister, Lois Southard Gise of Centreville, MD; a

nephew, Glenn A. Gise of Phoenix, MD; two nieces, Sally Rosenberry of Centreville, MD and Adele Quatmann of West Chester, PA and five great nieces and nephews and also James Guth of Gainesville, FL and David Guth of Lawrence, KS.

Memorial Service will be held at the Old Wye Church, Wye Mills, MD on Saturday, October 28, 2006 at 2:00 PM.
